## NENA GENERAL MEETING

- Role call
  - 6 board members present
  
- Lt. Joe Burke, APD- Lt. of Police & Communities Together
  - Property crime- High volume of auto and home burglaries
  - Encouraging citizens to make themselves harder targets
  - Security property through design control
  - Most popular stolen vehicles are Ford F150 and Honda Civic because they are easy to gain access to
  - Encourage your neighbors to get involved, report crimes
  - On NextDoor, neighbors have reports drug transactions near Barstow bridge during weekend nights and lunch time during school
  - Regarding the Oakland shooting, the investigation is on going, waiting for forensics
  - Cameras at Wyoming and Alameda do not belong to APD
  - What happens to surveillance media? It goes to the sergeant who then gives it to the investigator. It is tagged as evidence and can be used in court.
  - There is no ordinance regarding camera placement.

After the Oakland shooting, there was increased APD patrols at 2 am and it was a topic discussed at the bi-weekly meeting at the NE Area Command.

  - Boundaries
    - Jason Young worked with ONC
    - Boundaries need to be a max of 1 square mile, NENA is 2.5 sq mi
    - Jason presented 3 options:
      - in 2006, NENA approved to expand and absorb the annexed area, but paperwork is missing
      - North Abq Acres vote to take the annexed area last year
      - Do nothing

Brooke Bassan requested that North Abq Acres, NENA, and ONC meet privately.

Carol from North Abq Acres will coordinate this meeting with ONC.

- By-laws
  - Will need to be updated after boundary discussion
  - Written boundaries are on file with ONC
  - Jim Griffee was appointed to chair this committee.
- National Night Out- August
  - Part of the Neighborhood Watch Program
  - Request to set up a social event
  - The June General meeting will used to plan the August event
- La Cueva HS Parking
  - Due to parking renovation at LCHS, there was a complaint that students were parking on both sides of residential streets, making it difficult for residents to get to their homes
  - Brooke will send a letter to La Cueva
- June Meeting
  - Potential speaker- Tim Keller
  - John Ingram will post the next meeting on NextDoor
  - Request to move the Sept board meeting to May- passed
  - Next board meeting is May 2
- District 4 Coalition Minutes
  - Traffic light at Louisiana and Holly, construction will start in April
  - Bekka from Brad Winter's office said the city is looking into a traffic light at Palomas and Wyoming
  - North Domingo Baca MGC Gym and the traffic light will need to get bonds passed for funding.
  - The pool at NDBMGC was defunded for the gym.
